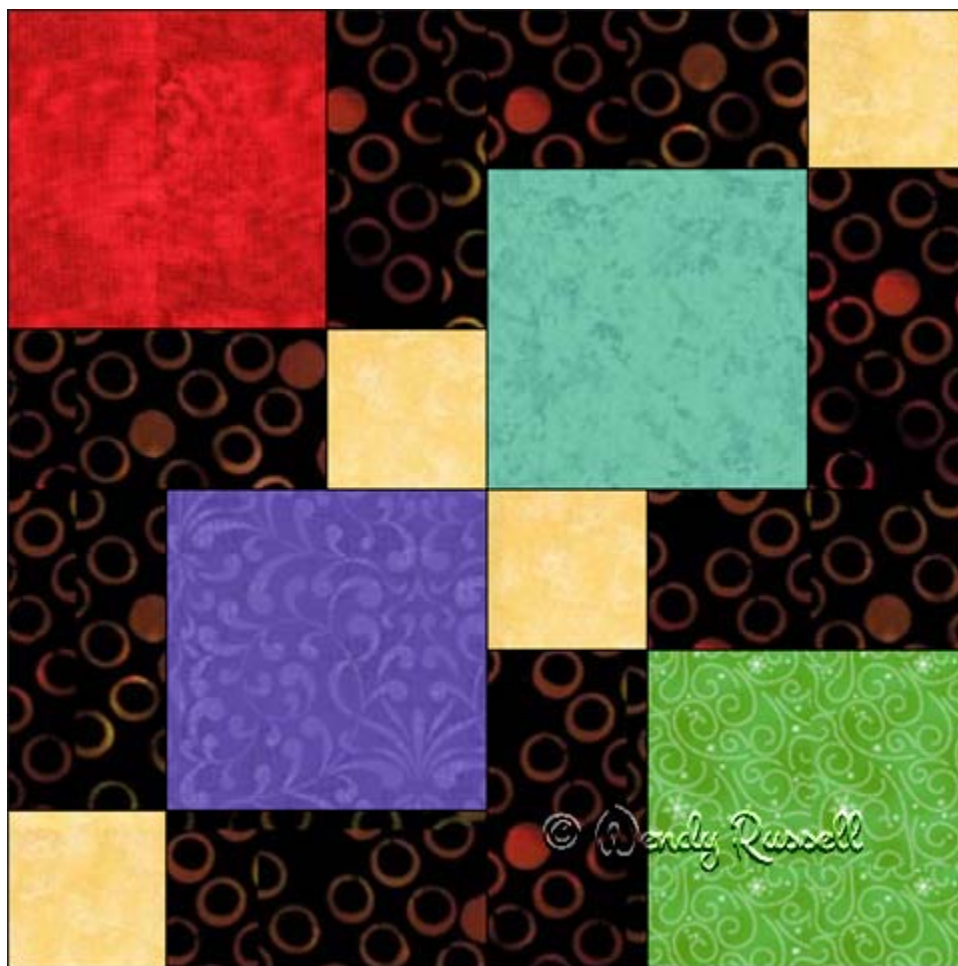


Disappearing Nine Patch

9" finished quilt block*

6" finished quilt block*

*These blocks will actually finish at $\frac{1}{4}$ " larger than listed but this is the closest I can get to the whole number size for the blocks, using this quick piecing method. So these block sizes will actually be $12\frac{1}{4}$ ", $9\frac{1}{4}$ " and $6\frac{1}{4}$ " once sewn as a quilt.

Cut 1 square of each fabric 2 3/4"

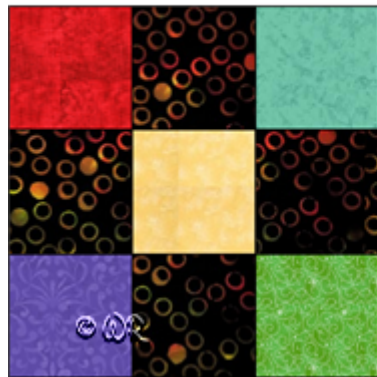
Disappearing Nine Patch

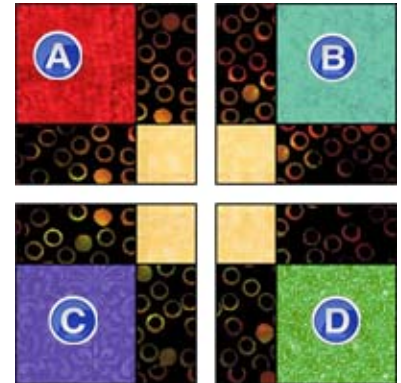
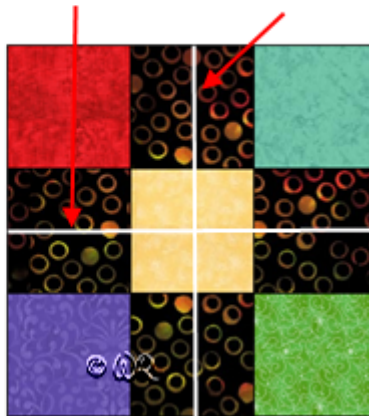

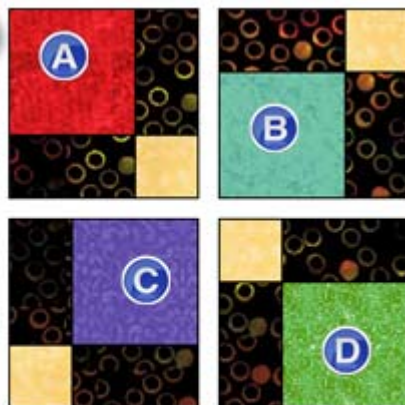
Press the quilt block

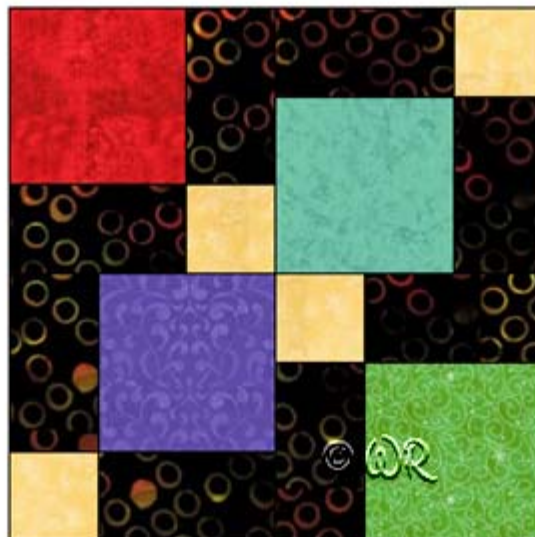
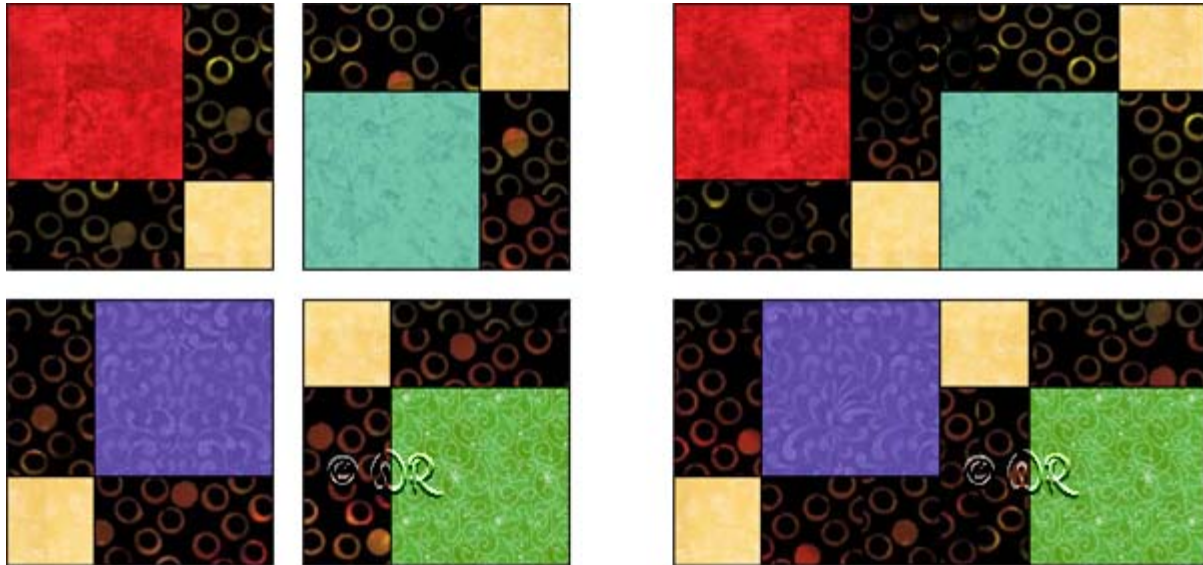
Rotate patches **B** and **C**
