#### Background fabric 1

Cut 4 squares 4 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal  
Cut 16 squares 2 1/2"

#### Assorted fabrics for remainder of pieces

Cut 8 squares 4 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal to yield 16 triangles. (You will use half of these triangle pieces for one block and retain the remaining 8 triangles for another block.)



Cut 16 squares 2 1/2"



*\*Hint: To get a truly scrappy quilt, make many half square triangle patches and many "checkerboard" patches before starting to assemble your blocks. This will yield more variety in your resultant blocks.*

Cut 16 squares 2"

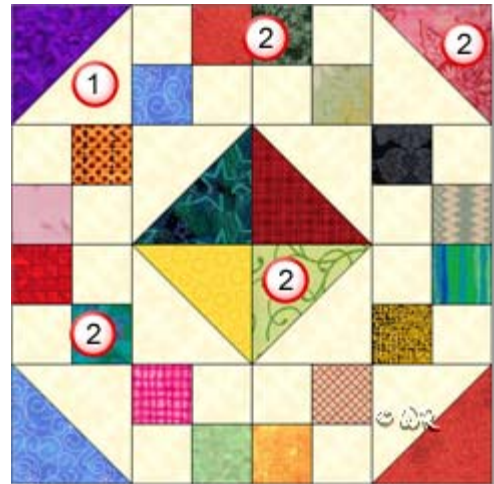

Cut 16 squares 1 1/2"



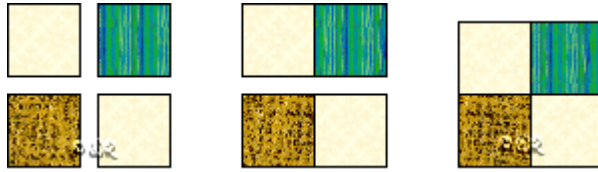

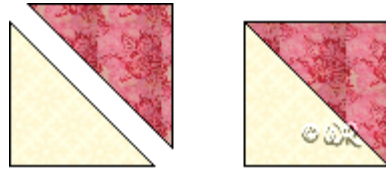

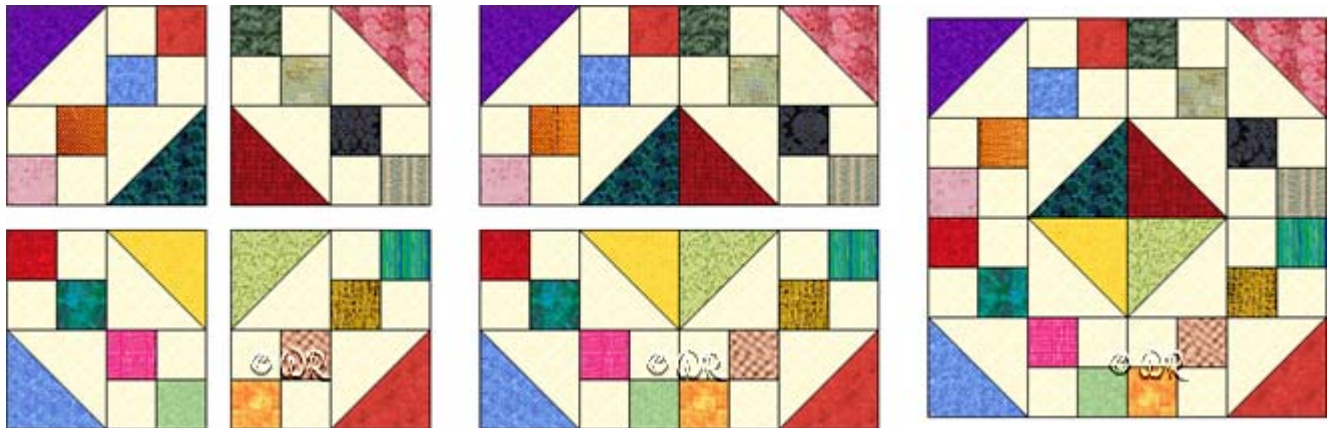
