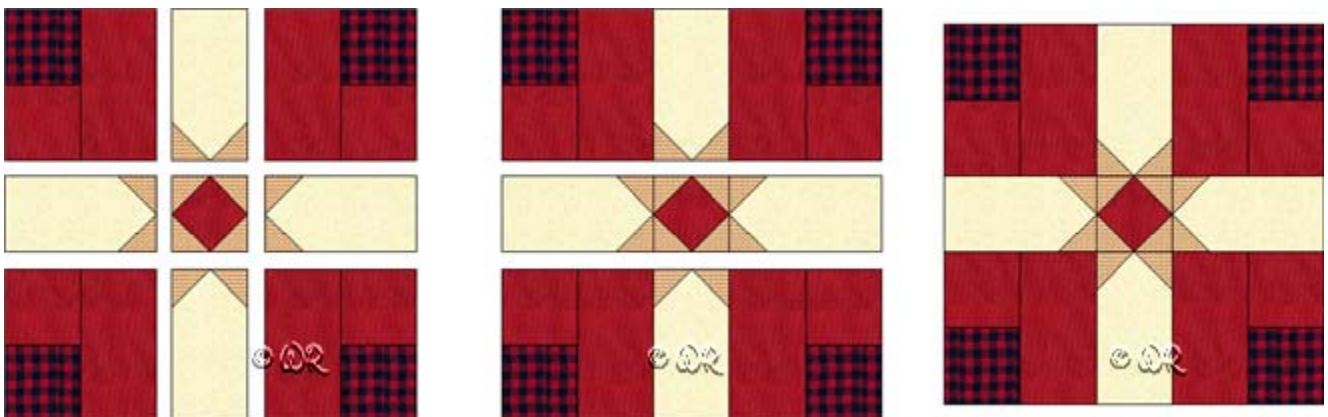
Make centre patch using the instructions on pages 6 and 7. This method uses all squares — no triangles are cut.

***Note:** Fabrics are different on instruction page



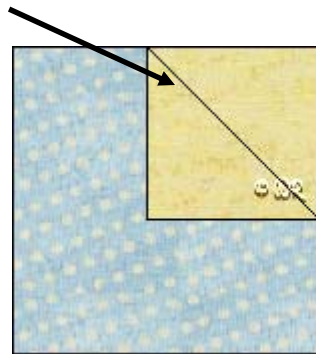
Make 4 of these units following instructions on page 8.

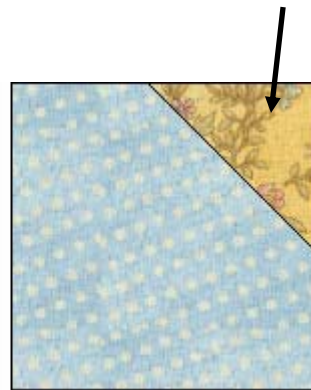


“Square in a Square” Patch — Method, using only squares

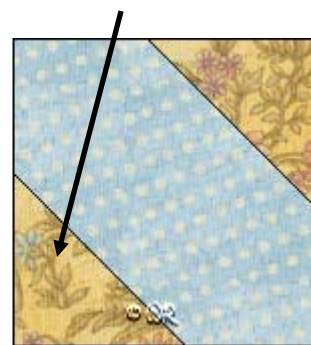
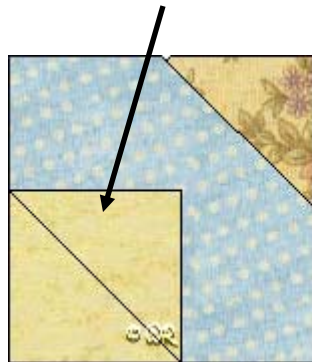
1. Draw pencil line, corner to corner on wrong side of small square
2. Place fabrics right sides together
3. Sew on drawn pencil line



4. Press to outer edge



5. Repeat process for opposite corner

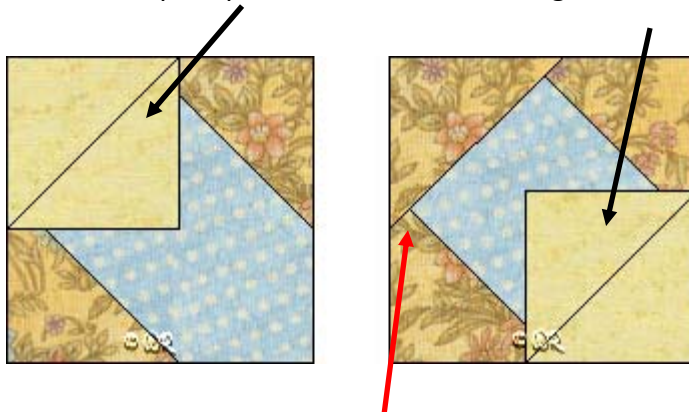

“Square in a Square” Patch — Method, using only squares

6. Repeat process for two remaining corners



**** Important Sewing Note ****

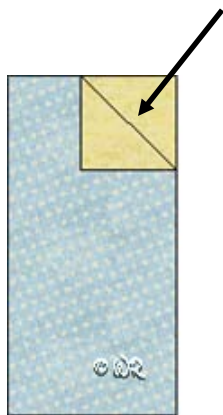
*Points of centre square do not reach outer edge
— leaving the seam allowance for next seam*



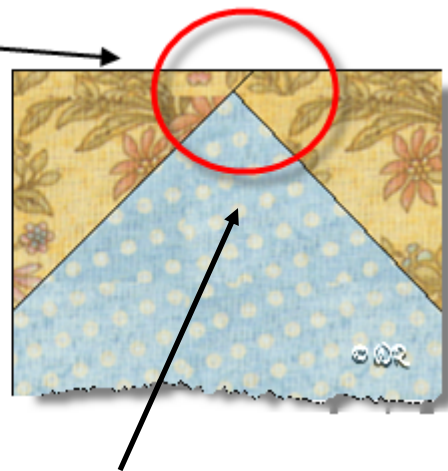
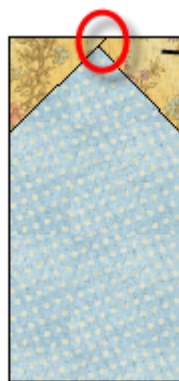
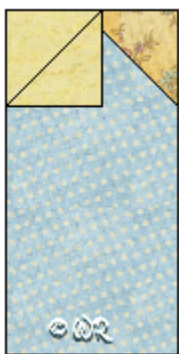
Final Patch should look like this

“Arrow” Points — Method, using only squares

1. Draw pencil line, corner to corner on wrong side of small square
2. Place fabrics right sides together
3. Sew on drawn pencil line
4. Press to outer edge



5. Repeat process for second corner



**** Important Sewing Note ****

“Arrow” Point of rectangle does not reach outer edge — to allow for the seam allowance for next seam
