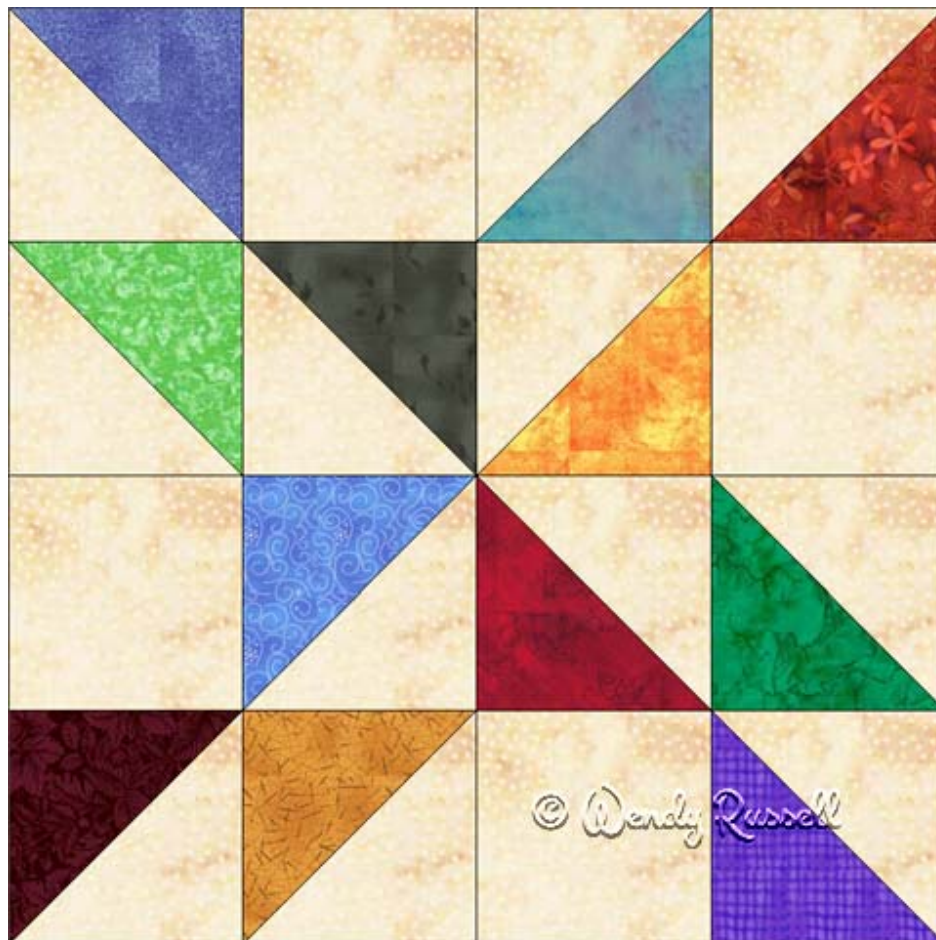

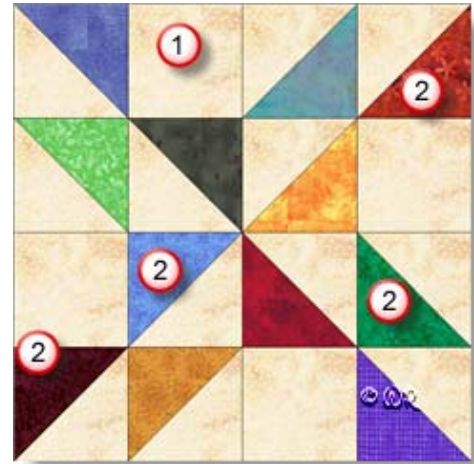

How-to Notes



Bisect square on one diagonal



Bisect square on both diagonals

*All seam allowances are 1/4" unless noted otherwise

Background fabric 1

4 squares 3 1/2"

6 squares 3 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal

Option 2—Assorted darker fabrics (for good contrast to background fabric)



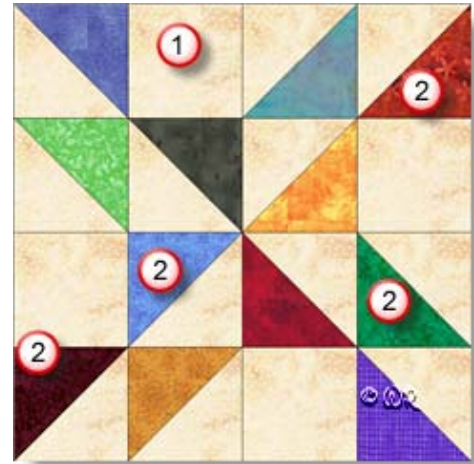
6 squares 3 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal (*This will yield 12 triangles. For the "scrappy" version, you may wish to use many fabrics to get a truly "scrappy" look*)

6 squares 3 1/8" and bisect on one diagonal

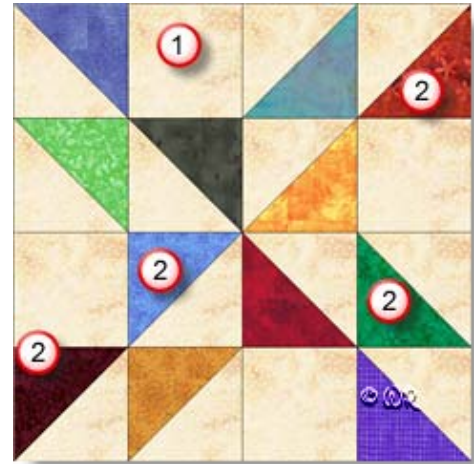

6 squares $2\frac{7}{8}$ " and bisect on one diagonal

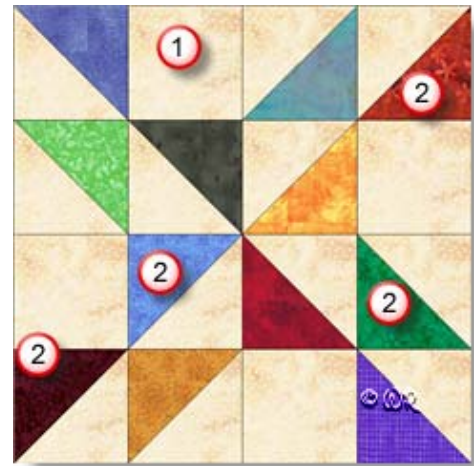

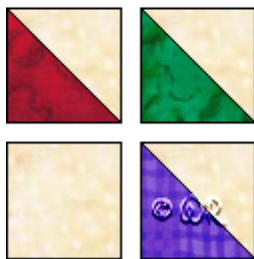
