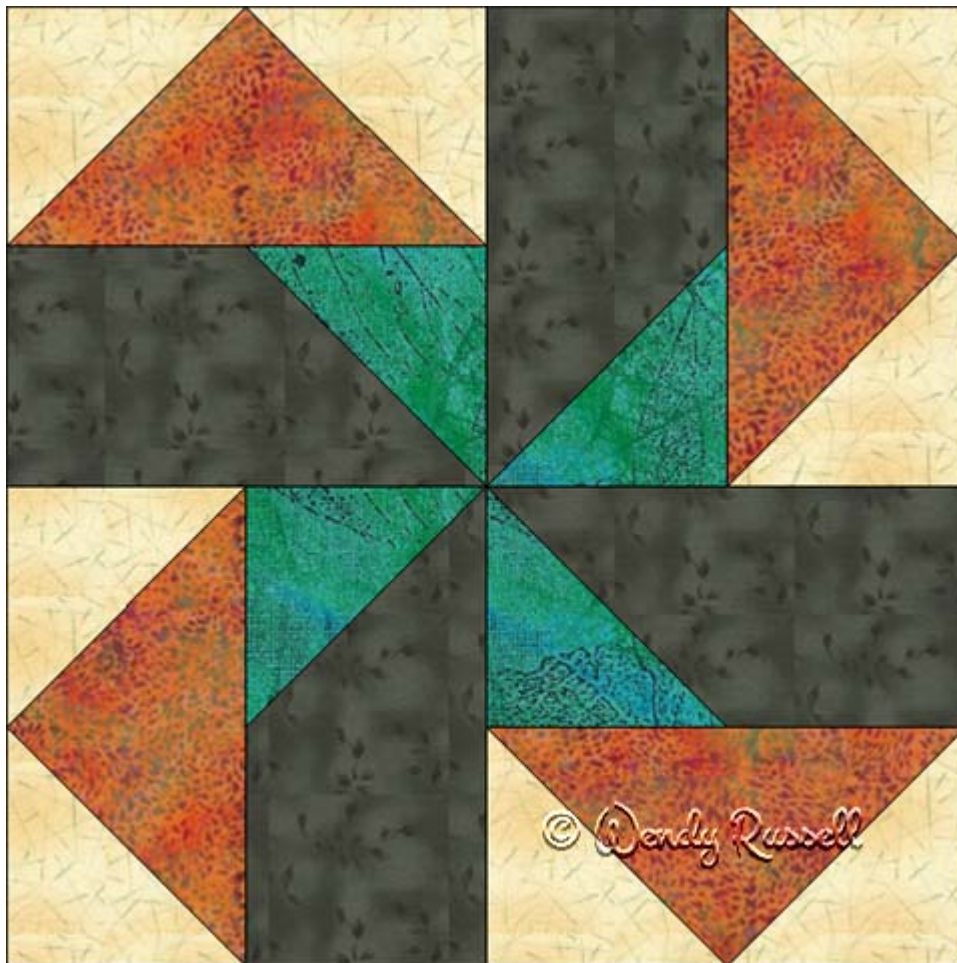

6" finished quilt block

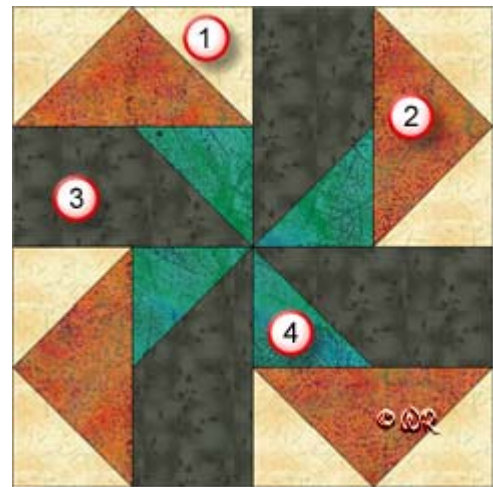

Fabric Placement



### How-to Notes



Bisect square on one diagonal



Bisect square on both diagonals

\*All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and included in cutting measurements unless noted otherwise

**Fabric 1**

Cut 4 squares  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " and bisect on one diagonal

2



**Fabric 2**

Cut 1 square  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " and bisect on both diagonals

3



**Fabric 3**

Cut 4 rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

**Fabric 4**

Cut 4 squares  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

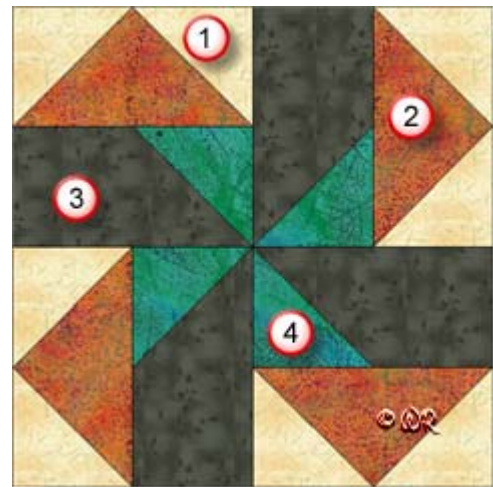

Fabric Placement



### How-to Notes



Bisect square on one diagonal



Bisect square on both diagonals

\*All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and included in cutting measurements unless noted otherwise

**Fabric 1**

Cut 4 squares  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " and bisect on one diagonal

**Fabric 2**

Cut 1 square  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " and bisect on both diagonals

3



**Fabric 3**

Cut 4 rectangles  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

**Fabric 4**

Cut 4 squares  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

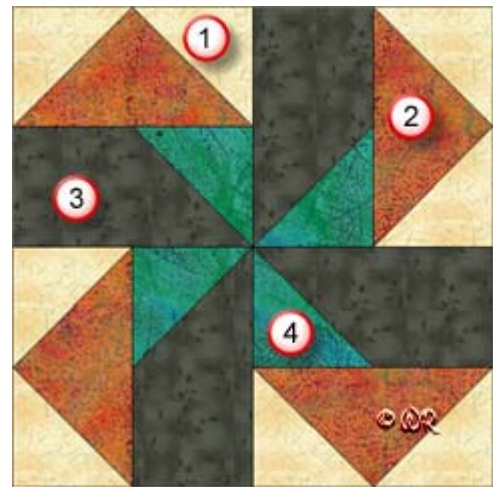

### How-to Notes



Bisect square on one diagonal



Bisect square on both diagonals

**Fabric 1**

Cut 4 squares  $2 \frac{3}{8}$ " and bisect on one diagonal

**Fabric 2**

Cut 1 square  $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " and bisect on both diagonals

3



**Fabric 3**

Cut 4 rectangles  $2$ " x  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ "

**Fabric 4**

Cut 4 squares  $2$ "

# Patchwork Square

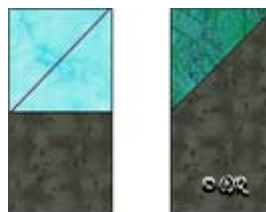
Free Quilt Block Pattern

## Seesaw

**“Blade” Points — No triangle method—using only squares**

1

1. Draw pencil line, corner to corner on wrong side of small square
2. Place fabrics right sides together
3. Sew on drawn pencil line
4. Press to outer edge
5. (Optional) Trim away excess fabric under triangle to reduce bulk



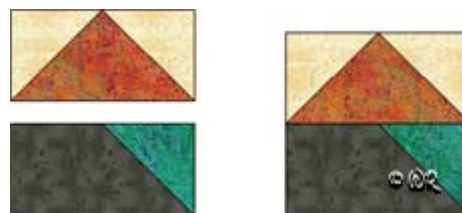
