

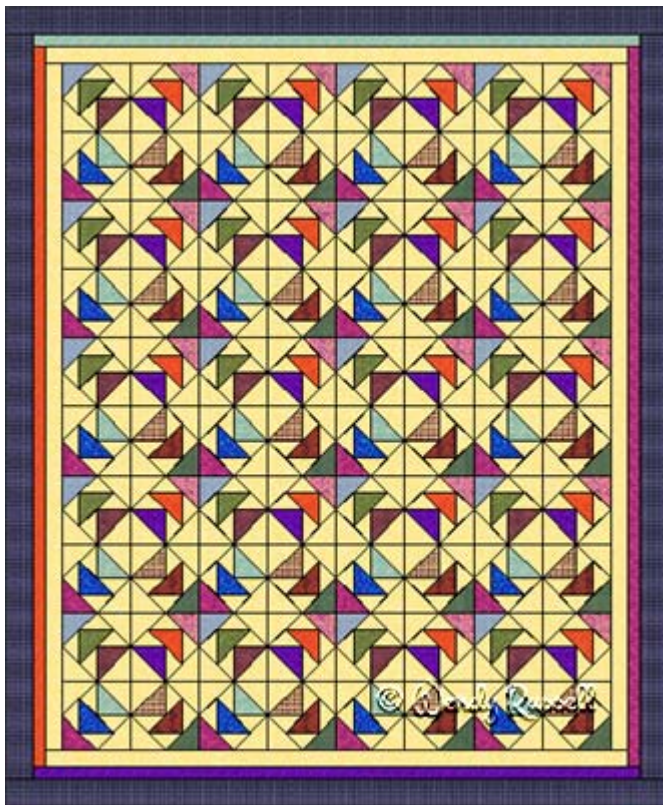

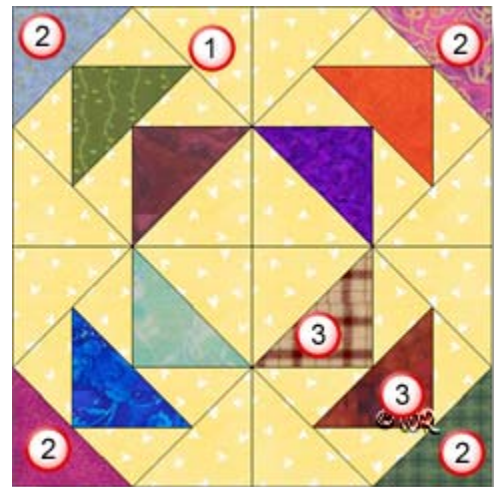
Sample Quilt Layouts

Fabric Placement



How-to Notes



Bisect square on one diagonal



Bisect square on both diagonals

*All seam allowances are 1/4" unless noted otherwise

Background fabric

Cut 6 squares 3 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal
Cut 8 squares 3" and bisect on one diagonal

Assorted fabrics

For four outer corners—



Cut 4 squares 3 7/8" and bisect on one diagonal to yield 4 triangles (you will have 4 extra triangles for a second block)

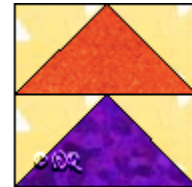
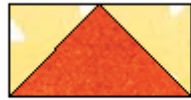
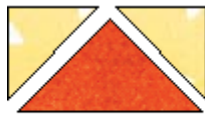
*Flying geese patches— *Note each square will yield 4 triangles*



Cut 2 squares 5 1/2" and bisect on **both** diagonals to yield 8 triangles for each block. (For a truly "scrappy" look, use several different squares and retain extra triangles for other blocks.)

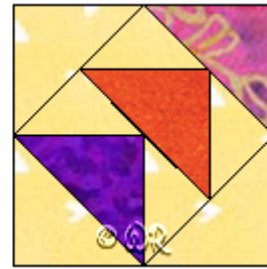
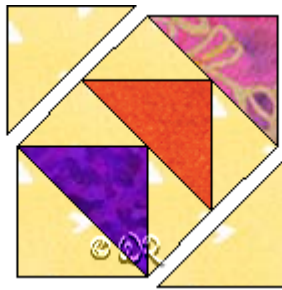
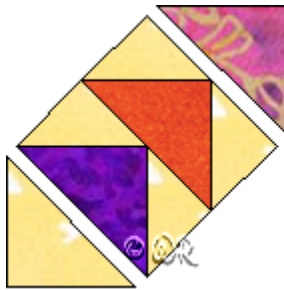
