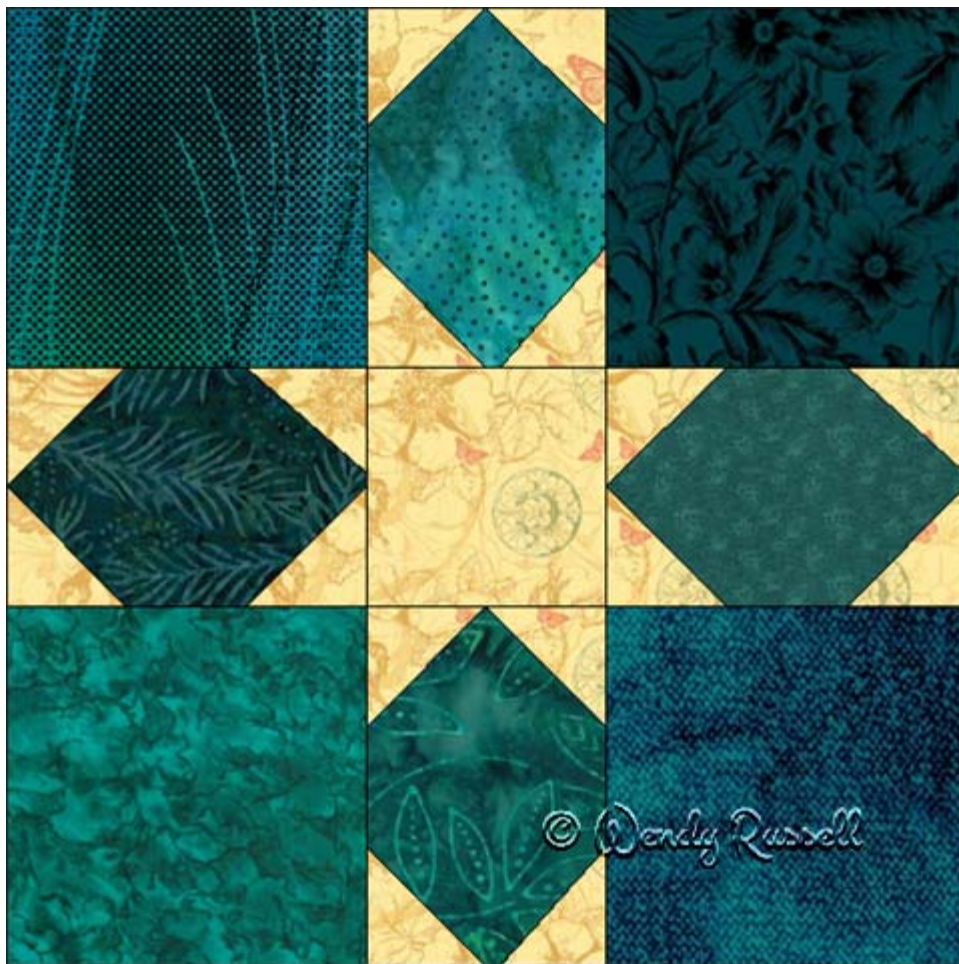

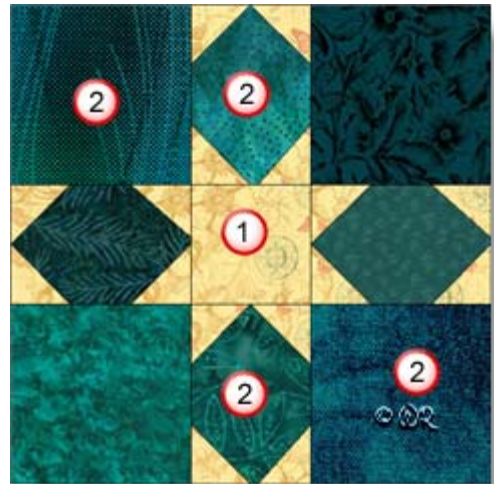

Fabric Placement



### How-to Notes



Bisect square on one diagonal



Bisect square on both diagonals

\*All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and included in cutting measurements unless noted otherwise

#### Fabric 1

Cut 1 square  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "  
Cut 16 squares 2"

#### Fabric 2 (or assorted fabrics with contrast to Fabric 1)

Cut 4 squares 5"  
Cut 4 rectangles  $5" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$

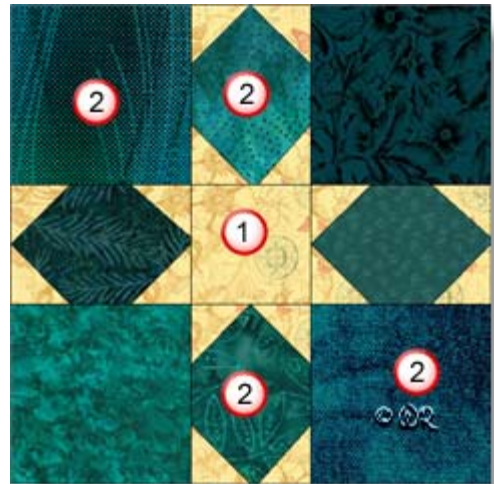

#### Fabric 1

Cut 1 square  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  
Cut 16 squares  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

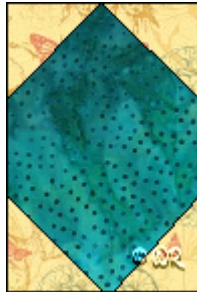

#### Fabric 2 (or assorted fabrics with contrast to Fabric 1)

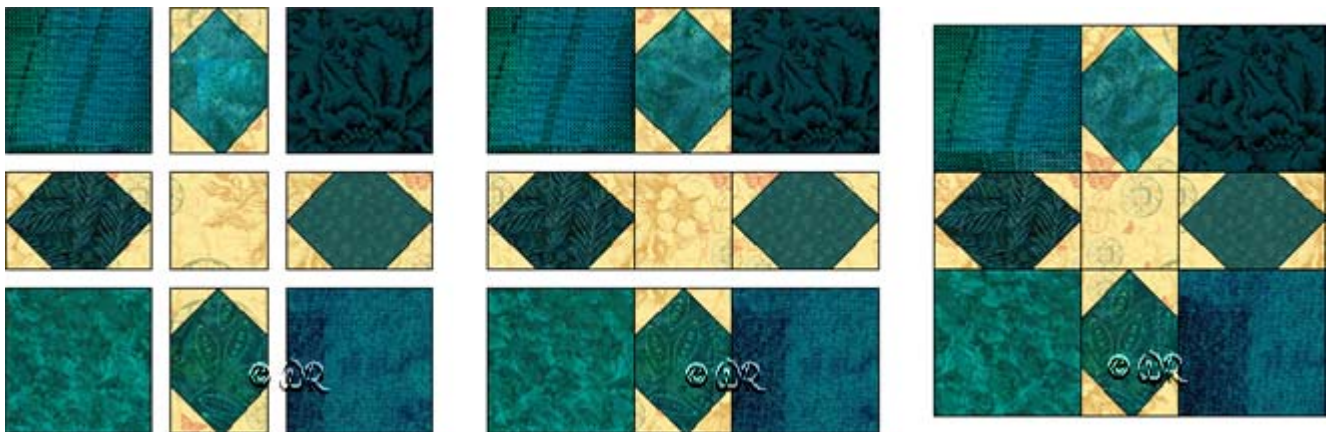
Cut 4 squares  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "  
Cut 4 rectangles  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

## Vestibule



Make 4

Using the method described on the following page, make 4 of these units.  
(It's a fun way to make these patches as you do not sew a single triangle.)



## ***“Arrow” Points Method — No triangle method—using only squares***

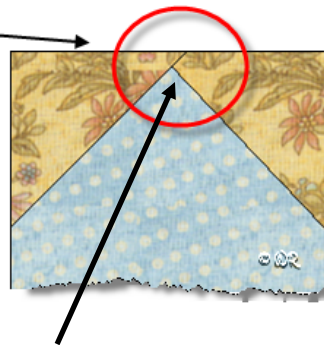
1. Draw pencil line, corner to corner on wrong side of small square
2. Place fabrics right sides together
3. Sew on drawn pencil line



4. Press to outer edge



5. Repeat process for second corner



### ***\*\* Important Sewing Note \*\****

*“Arrow” Point of rectangle does not reach outer edge — to allow for the seam allowance for next seam*

6. Repeat above steps for opposite side of rectangle
